My wife and I have lived on Highland Road , Brighton for 27 years , where we've raised our 3 sons ,to us it's our extended backyard that we've loved over the years .

We oppose any development of a landfill facility, which will have a negative adverse effect on the environment and neighbouring residents

I understand that the Tender Name :LTES SoW Enable development of Smooth Hill (Waste Futures Phase 2 – Workstream 3) .

I noticed the word Enable was used in the tender name , in all the 96 latest tenders not once was the word Enable used . So GHD of Auckland won the tender to Enable ie (make it happen , permit , validate or make it possible) .

So of course the council get what they wanted, enforcing the Engineers to Enable a land waste facility.

The Tender name should have read, Prepare an Environmental Impact Assessment and Statement for a Modern Engineered Landfill Facility at Smooth Hill .

A landfill waste land brings with it toxic waste, that will eventually make its way into our water way, in or over 50 years' time.

It seems crazy to have a landfill waste so close to a forestry, fires at a landfill are a constant threat caused either by mechanical machinery or batteries, example Nelson ,York Valley landfill over a 12 month period reported 20 fires sparked by batteries (Stuff News 17-10-2021) so the Laws of Logic there's going to be fires .
