I oppose the submission. This will hugely impact on our life in Big Stone Road. The risk of air, soil, and water pollution will affect our area and that of Brighton beach. This is degradation of our land and waterways! I lived near the Green Island Landfill as a child and witnessed the pollution caused to the area first-hand. The noise, odour, birds, vermin, and pollution. The Kaikorai Stream leading

to the estuary at Waldronville was always discoloured often dead birds could be found in the area. It has ruined the estuary and Waldronville beach, and I fear this will happen to Brighton Beach also. My children and I will never swim in the Creek or the beach again should this be allowed to go ahead. This is the legacy we leave the next generation?! There are residents that live within 1km of the proposed site and these houses were built within the last few years. Why was this subdivision allowed to go ahead and why wasn't it noted on the LIM reports. We bought our land 28 years ago and never knew of the proposal. If we had known at the time we wouldn't have purchased the property. Fire is another huge risk especially with the area covered in trees, it would potentially risk people's lives. Brighton only has a voluntary fire brigade. The area often has huge flocks of birds which fly along the coast these too pose a risk to aircraft with the airport only 4-5kms away from this site. The area has had many landslips in the time we have lived here and with the Akatore fault line running just off the coast these also could cause a catastrophic disaster,

I seek the following decision from the consent authority (*give precise details, including the general nature of any conditions sought*)

I propose the Landfill is not allowed to proceed. There are alternative sites including the landfill in Winton.
