Background

- 1 My full name is Bradley James May
- 2 I am an Orchard Worker.

Purpose of evidence

- 3 This evidence is provided in relation to the applications by Cromwell Certified Concrete Limited to Central Otago District Council and Otago Regional Council for discharge permits, a water permit and a land use consent relating to expansion of an existing quarry at 1248 Luggate-Cromwell Road.
- 4 The purpose of this evidence is to document the effects the existing quarry operations have had on our work at Hayden Little Family Trust orchard on Amisfield Burn, Amisfield Road (paper).

Dust effects

- 5 When working for a contractor at the Property on 31st August 2020, I experienced significant windblown dust from the quarry site.
- 6 On 31 August 2020, the adverse dust effects from the existing quarry operations were so bad it effected our breathing and eyes. We had to stop tree planting at the Property due to these adverse dust effects.
- 7 The dust crossed the full width of the orchard and into the neighbouring orchard to the south.
- 8 A photo of the event attached as **Appendix A** adequately demonstrates the conditions experienced.
