## Water Metering Tips

- Ensure your measuring device is recording accurately by completing several checks during the irrigation season, especially after increase in sediment.
- Flow verifications need to be completed as per your consent and the Water metering Regulations.
- Verification document (RS1) should be submitted to ORC within one month of each verification being undertaken.
- Water metering records need to be submitted to ORC by 31 July each year.
