

## Smooth Hill consent condition – Rūnaka involvement in monitoring

113. The consent holder must, in collaboration with Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou, prepare a plan specifying how Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou will be involved in both baseline monitoring and ongoing monitoring of the effects of the landfill operation. The plan must include, but not necessarily be limited to, the following:

- a) The specific components of the monitoring programme that Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou will be involved in, and the nature of that involvement;
- b) Agreed resourcing and support to be provided for Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou participation in the monitoring programme;
- c) A process for periodic review of the plan by the consent holder and Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou.

The agreed Plan must be submitted to Otago Regional Council before the date of commencement of baseline monitoring. Any amendments to the plan arising from a review in 113(c) must be provided to Otago Regional Council within 3 months of the review.
