

May it please the Freshwater Hearing Panel (the Panel),

The following matters are put forward on behalf of the Director-General of Conservation Tumuaki Ahurei (the Director-General)

1. I refer to Minute 4, issued by the Chair of the Panel on 22 June 2023.
2. That Minute directs that submitters identify what evidence from the non-freshwater hearing process they wish to have taken into account in the freshwater process.
3. I request the following is taken as re-filed in the freshwater process;

 - c. Dr Marine Richarson
 - i. Evidence dated 23 November 2022 in its entirety;
 - ii. pORPS – Ecosystems and Indigenous Biodiversity Chapter (ECO) – speaking notes for Dr Marine Richarson produced 19 April 2023;
 - iii. pORPS – Land and Freshwater chapter (LF) – speaking notes for Dr Marine Richarson dated 2 May 2023 and produced 9 May 2023.
4. Please note that expert evidence specific to the freshwater proceeding from Mr Brass, Mr McKinlay, Dr Richarson, and Dr Dunn has been filed today 28 June 2023.
