APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO CROSS-EXAMINE BY THE OTAGO REGIONAL COUNCIL

May it please the Panel:

Introduction

- 1 This application responds to paragraph 5 of Minute 1 dated 10 May 2023.
- The ORC seeks leave to cross-examine the expert planning witnesses listed in the **attached** table.
- The **attached** table also lists the proposed topics and estimated time required.
- 4 The grounds for this application are:
 - 4.1 There are material differences between witnesses on the topics listed.
 - 4.2 The interests of justice are served by allowing cross examination to test the positions of the expert planning witnesses.
 - 4.3 The interests of justice should be determined by reference to the subject matter of the hearing and its desired outcome (the Panel's best-informed recommendations on the pORPS).
 - 4.4 The interests of justice should be construed broadly given the limited appeal rights under the Freshwater Planning Process.
 - 4.5 The ORC as the local authority preparing the pORPS must meet the requirements of the RMA and instruments made under it. To do so the ORC should test, and ensure that it fully understands, the reasoning of the expert planning witnesses.
 - 4.6 Because the ORC has the final right of reply it has a duty where possible to put matters it may raise in that reply to the relevant witnesses. For example, a section 42A author may propose further amendment to the pORPS as a result of submitter evidence. Such an amendment should be put to the relevant witnesses.
 - 4.7 Absent such a duty, putting reply points (such as any proposed further amendments) to the expert planning witnesses is in the interests of justice in that it provides a fair opportunity for the witness

to respond to the point, and best informs the Panel in making its recommendations.
