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MAY IT PLEASE THE PANEL

- Manawa Energy Limited (Manawa) presented its case to the Panel on 31 August 2023.
- At the hearing the Panel questioned the scope of changes proposed to clause
 (b) of LF-FW-P7A. The concern appeared to be the priority in water allocation afforded to <u>new</u> renewable electricity generation.
- 3. Manawa clarified that this was not the intent, and that it would give some thought to the wording that had been proposed.
- 4. To this end, Ms Styles has reviewed the proposed wording and recommends the following which better aligns with the phrasing used in the NPS REG (eg Policy B a)) as follows:

LF-FW-P7A - Water allocation and use

Within limits and in accordance with any relevant environmental flows and levels, the benefits of using fresh water are recognised and over-allocation is either phased out or avoided by:

- (1) allocating fresh water efficiently to support the social, economic, and cultural well-being of people and communities to the extent possible within limits, including prioritising allocation of available fresh water for:
 - (a) community drinking water supplies, **and**
 - (b) maintaining existing generation output and capacity and future generation from existing renewable electricity generation schemes, and then
 - (c) land-based primary production, <u>and then</u>
 - (d) other commercial and industrial uses,
- (2) ensuring that no more fresh water is abstracted than is necessary for its intended use,
