I support this application in its entirety. I have recently moved to Christchurch but was a resident in Dunedin, frequently visiting and staying in Taieri Mouth. I still regularly rent a holiday home across the river from the applicants wharf. The current view is unsightly with 2 old containers, but have noticed a significant amount of work on this wharf where the applicants have secured the pontoon, made it structurally sound and re-decked the wharf which is a much welcomed

improvement. There are other wharves currently that are in a dire state and no are longer used for commercial fishing given the demise of the industry at Taieri Mouth.

I like and support the look of the proposed build. It represents a traditional wooden boat shed with an industrial twist, yet compliments the natural environment with its dark colours and blends rather than competes with the surroundings.

I applaud the applicants that their boatshed can accommodate those with disabilities. To have safe access to boat by way of the modified crane at considerable expense is a huge public and community benefit.

To offer the pontoon for the same reasons and for emergency services to finally have a dry, safe access point is again a massive benefit to all the community.

I believe that the applicants will donate a percentage of each rental income back into the community coffers, I cannot imagine other vacation rentals in the area doing the same, and again am impressed at their generosity.

This can only be an improvement on an area that used to be the hub of Taieri Mouth in its hay day of fishing. Given that industry is now less than a handful of fishing boats and will never return to what it was, I wonder what the future of these wharves will be without innovative ideas such as this proposal is about.

If the application is subject to limited notification, the consent authority may adopt an earlier closing date for submissions once the consent authority receives responses from all affected persons.

You must serve a copy of your submission on the applicant as soon as is reasonably practicable after you have served your submission on the consent authority.

**Privacy:** Please note that submissions are public. Your name and submission will be included in papers that are available to the media and the public, including publication on the Council website. Your submission will only be used for the purpose of the notified resource consent process

If you are a trade competitor, your right to make a submission may be limited by the trade competition provisions in <u>Part 11A</u> of the Resource Management Act 1991.
