## Councillor declaration of interest register

The guiding principle for Councillor declarations in the interest register is set out in the Otago Regional Council's Code of Conduct<sup>9</sup>, which states:

"Ethical behaviour – Members should not place themselves in situations where their honesty and integrity may be questioned, should not behave improperly and should on all occasions avoid the appearance of such behaviour".

In addition, the Local Authorities (Members' Interests) Act 1968 is concerned with members' financial and non-financial interests. The Office of the Auditor General notes a conflict of interest can arise when "a member's or official's duties or responsibilities to a public entity could be affected by some other interest of duty that the member or official may have". 10

Keeping Councillors' declaration of interest register, both financial and non-financial, allows the member and Council to identify and manage a conflict of interest when it arises. The register should also include any such interest(s) held by a Councillor's partner or spouse.

The register must be reviewed annually.<sup>11</sup> If a Councillor is in doubt as to whether or not a particular course of action, including a decision to take no action, raises a conflict of interest, then the member should seek guidance from the Chief Executive immediately.

Where a Councillor's circumstances change, the Councillor must ensure the Register of Interests is updated as soon as possible.

The information in the completed declarations will be publicly available on the Council's website.
