# NZ Sea Lion (Male)

Blunt nose, <3.5m in length, 250-400kg, dark coloured fur



# NZ Sea Lion (Female)

Blunt nose, <2m in length, 100-160kg, honey coloured fur



#### **NZ Fur Seal**

Pointy nose, smaller than Sea Lion, long pale whiskers, body covered in two layers of fur.



### **Leopard Seal**

Large, snake-snake like head. Grey fur, black spots. Males: <3m in length, 270kg. Females: <3.5m in length, 300kg.



# **Yellow Eyed Penguin**

Grey-blue, white belly, pink feet, yellow head band.



### **Little Blue Penguin**

Head and upper body are blue, and white from chin to belly. Flippers and beak are blue. <35cm height, 1.5kg
