Submission Opposing Consent Application to take water from Royal Burn North Branch and New Chums Creek

Submission lodged by –Mylore Family Trust on behalf of LM and GJ Irwin

We bought our 87 hectare property on 53 Jeffrey Road 18 years ago and took over shares at the Lofts Water Limited at this time. We are intensively farming this ground with approximately 1000 stock units consisting of red and wapiti cross deer. We are reliant solely on Lofts Scheme water for 50% of our most productive part of our farm. This water is required for the hygiene in the deer shed which is a requirement by law for velveting stags and for animal welfare.

Water is essential for the health and welfare for stags, lactating hinds and fawns at foot. Especially during the hot Central Otago conditions when stock is at their most stressed. We have 10 water troughs that require clean consistent water for stock health. There has been documented major losses of deer when water has not been available to them. Without the supply of water it would make our productive farm uneconomic as stock numbers would have to be drastically reduced.

We have no objections to the applicant getting water but do object to the control and amount that has been requested from the Royal Burn and Chum Creek. This is unfair to other users on the Lofts scheme who are reliant on consistent amount of water to carry on their day to day operations. Our own use of this water is solely for farming operations and stock health and not for irrigation or recreational use.
